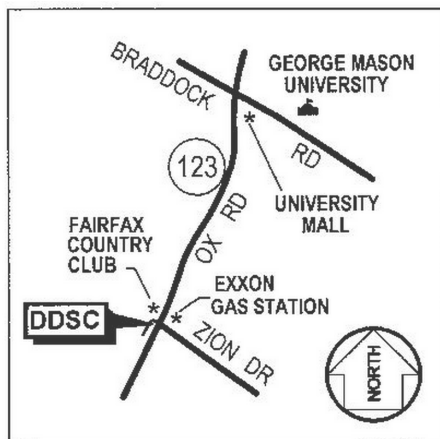

He has been abbot of Sera Mey Monastery since August 2011, when appointed by His Holiness, the Dalai Lama. Jangste Rinpoche (Tenzin Khechok) will serve as Rinpoche's translator.
